Contributions: Normally 5,000 to 7,000 words, submissions must be previously unpublished and not under consideration elsewhere. Submissions can be sent as email attachments to *wade@wheaton.edu* or via <https://journals.wheaton.edu/index.php/vii/about/submissions>. Manuscripts should follow the *MLA Handbook - Eighth Edition* using in-text citations and endnotes. The author's name should appear only on a removable cover sheet. All unsolicited submissions are blind-reviewed. Decision time is normally four to six months. There is no monetary payment for publication, but the author will receive one complimentary copy of the volume in which the article appears and a one-year digital subscription to *VII*.

In 1965, in response to the growing interest in these seven British authors, Dr. Clyde S. Kilby of Wheaton College established a research collection. Beginning with a small number of books and fifteen letters by C.S. Lewis, the Marion E. Wade Center now holds thousands of manuscripts, letters, first editions, and other primary materials.

Fifteen years later, in 1980, Dr. Barbara Reynolds, Dr. Beatrice Batson, and Dr. Kilby founded *VII: An Anglo-American Literary Review* as most scholarship on these authors was then coming from the UK and the US. In 2015, in order to reflect the now international appeal of these writers, the journal's subtitle was changed to *VII: Journal of the Marion E. Wade Center*. The original aim of *VII* remains constant: to provide the opportunity for discussion and balanced assessment of these writers. *VII* is intended for both the general and specialized reader. We welcome you to this forum.
